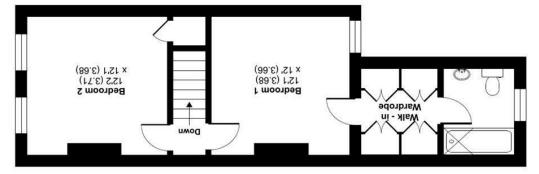




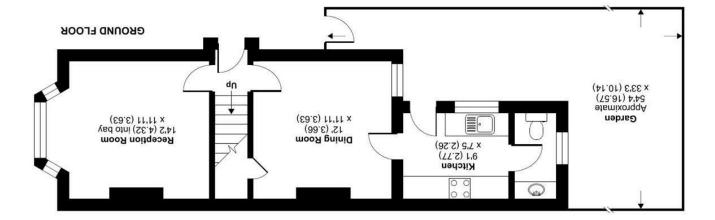
## Lavender Road, Carshalton, SM5

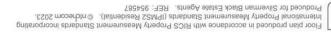

Originally a three bedroom house, a previous owner has reconfigured the smallest bedroom to create a walk-in dressing room and an en-suite bathroom - so the current accommodation incorporates two well-proportioned reception rooms, a sizable & well-equipped kitchen and a cloakroom on the ground floor, with two generous double bedrooms, the dressing room and the en-suite bathroom on the first floor. Externally, the property has the benefits of a private block paved parking area at the front and a secure 55 ft rear garden, which enjoys a bright south-easterly aspect and is mainly laid to lawn. Wallington town centre and BR station (giving access to London Bridge & East Croydon) is only ten minutes walk/0.5 miles away - whilst Carshalton High Street is roughly a five minutes walk from the house. Other local facilities include The Westcroft Leisure Centre and The Grove - one of London's premier Victorian urban parks - which are 0.25 miles distant, whilst All Saints Junior School and Wallington County Boys Grammar School are both with a ten minute walk. A delightful and charming cottage, viewing is very strongly recommended - so call today to book an appointment.
